## Vision

*"Where there is no vision, the people perish."  
(Proverbs 29:18)*

1. Vision is a revelation of God's plan for His people. It is what guides us, focuses us, motivates us, and completes our lives.
2. To perish means to go backwards, to disconnect from God's purpose. It means to be alive but not to really live as we were intended to live.
3. If we don't learn and do God's Vision, we disconnect ourselves from God's purpose and those we could have helped will not know Him.
4. God's Vision is what we can give our lives to...together.

## Integrity

*"Therefore, since through God's mercy we have this ministry, we do not lose heart. We have renounced secret and shameful ways, we do not use deception, nor do we distort the Word of God. On the contrary, by setting forth the truth plainly, we commend ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God." (2 Cor. 4:1-2)*

1. There are two types of integrity: Personal and Corporate.
2. "Integrity commits itself to character over personal gain, to people over things, to service over power, to principle over convenience, and to the long view over the immediate." John Maxwell
3. Integrity is living right when no one is looking.
4. Integrity is about paying attention to the small things. Integrity is:
  - Treating those who can do nothing for you with the highest honor and respect.
  - Being transparent/accountable with others
  - Being the same person when you are alone as you are in the spotlight...at home as you are in public.
  - Quickly admitting when you are wrong.
  - When you have a problem with someone you talk to them...not about them.
  - Doing what you should do before you do what you want to do.
5. Integrity is about having character that is not constantly being shaped by the latest environment you are put into.
