Faith Is A Verb! Understanding Faith As God Defines It Part 2 - (Matthew 7:13-23)

Review: James 2:10-26 – God defines faith as:

- A belief in Him and a life style that is faithful to the belief.
- A belief in Him with no obedient lifestyle is of no value (14), is a false claim (14), cannot save you (14), is dead (17, 26), is useless (20), and is incomplete (22).

1. The way that leads to eternal destruction is wide and broad. (13)
2. The way that leads to eternal destruction is popular and crowded. (13)
3. The way that leads to eternal life is small and narrow. (14)
4. The way that leads to eternal life is not popular and those who choose it are in the minority. (14)
5. False prophets make the broad way easier to believe and the narrow way harder to find. (15)
6. You can tell a false prophet by the quality of his personal, spiritual life and by the content of his message. (16-20)

7. Not everyone who calls Jesus their Lord will make it to heaven. (21)
8. Sometimes a false prophet will not even know he is one. (22)
9. The narrow way is inhabited by people who deliberately live their lives to do the will of their Heavenly Father. (21)
10. The narrow way is inhabited by people who know Jesus Christ personally. (23)
