Is Everything That Happens In My World and My Life, God's Will? (Genesis)

Where God's Sovereignty and Man's Free Will Meet: (Part 2)

7. As God relates with mankind in the new circumstance, He will give correction and punishment as He chooses. (4:5-7, 10-13)
8. It is never God's will that people sin or that their sin harms another. However, God will respect mankind's created ability to freely choose its own way and will allow the results -- good or bad, great or small -- to happen on the earth. (4:8)
 - Our choices affect us/our choices affect others.
 - The choices of others affect us.
 - God can change how the results of the free will of others affect our lives.

Through Prayer and Obedience: (Matthew 6:9-10)

- Sometimes God will not stop them. (Acts 12:1-2)
 - Sometimes God will stop them. (Acts 12:3-11)
 - Sometimes God will alter them. (Genesis 18, 19)
 - Sometimes God will soften them. (Acts 14:19-20)
 - Sometimes God will heal them. (Luke 17:11-19)
 - Sometimes God will redeem them. (Phil. 1:12-14)
 - Sometimes God will empower you to confront them. (Matthew 18:15-17)
9. True to His nature, God gives mercy and grants value to the lives of the unrepentant. (4:13-15, 17, 20-22)
 10. God leads and blesses those who will trust Him. (4:25-26)
